MESA: Mission: Evangelize Spanish America

Often times we donate to a cause because we trust the people or the ministry and that is a great thing. Good relationships are always built on trust. Always. As we launch into 2025, we want to share a few more details about plans for MESA and where your generous donations are being used in the kingdom.

You've been hearing the buzz...we are getting weekly requests to help Spanish ministries in the U.S.

Since the beginning of 2023, God has put us in contact with **40 churches** in the U.S. and 4 in Central America. Of these, 23 are already actively serving their communities and/or meeting on Sunday!

Our goal for 2024 is to have 40 actively evangelizing Spanish ministries in the MESA network.

What we are offering each ministry: Customized websites, commercials, creative digital content, marketingtools, social media management, geofencing and leadership consultation/development.

What we will be able to offer in 2025: Interns from Christian Universities. Harding University is on board and we are talking to Freed-Hardeman, Abilene Christian University, Lubbock Christian University, OCU and Lipscomb University to provide qualified students that want experience in cross cultural evangelism so they are equipped to establish or enhance ministries wherever they land after graduation.

What it costs: \$5,000/year per ministry.

Who do you know that would be interested in partnering with us? We need to hear from you! I am grateful the Herald of Truth helped me find a job preaching in Green Bay. MESA has provided opportunities for commercial development and we are able to advertise the church utilizing tools and platforms such as a website, social media assistance, and geofencing all created by Herald of Truth.

In the last 15 months, we have had a total of 163 people from 14 different countries attend our services and activities. MESA has been a great blessing to our outreach and we are grateful for all those who support the Herald of Truth to make this possible. International News

Imagine living in a country with shortages of food, medicine, and basic services, with continual rolling blackouts that can last hours or days. Add to that two hurricanes that sweep across your island nation, along with a series of earthquakes. What would you expect to be doing?

If you're Tony Fernández, Herald of Truth's representative in Cuba, you're traveling the island to take food and supplies to hurricane victims. You're working with a farm that provides food for hundreds. You're doing follow-up on Herald of Truth contacts and regularly visiting the prisons, orphanages, and retirement centers. And you're baptizing hundreds of people. As Herald of Truth's ministry in Cuba nears its 30th anniversary, God is opening doors for ministry in ways that we never dreamed possible.

And that's just one area of our international ministry. This year we've also conducted evangelism training in Honduras and Santo Domingo, spoken at conferences with church leaders from all over Latin America, and conducted an evangelistic campaign in Tegucigalpa, Honduras. We could also mention the teaching ministries of Bruno Valle and Tim Archer, working with training institutes both online and in person, preparing current and future ministers to serve more effectively in God's kingdom.

Because of your help, the work being done by Herald of Truth outside the United States is truly exciting!

Mission Updates

I have spent this fall, as I do much of the year, speaking about, teaching about, and doing evangelism. From churches as small as 30 or 40 to churches as large as 600. Multi-church workshops. Eldership and leadership meetings. People are hungry for truth and authenticity.
