MESA: MISSION EVANGELIZE SPANISH AMERICA

The World Cup has excited millions of Hispanics worldwide, especially those in the United States. Nationalities have come together to celebrate their team and culture while hoping for a win. The difficulty is that so many will be disappointed in the outcome because there can only be one champion.

The Hispanic churches in the United States strive to bring people together in Christ. MESA serves by creating a network for Spanish-speaking churches and ministers across the US. There are more than 50 active Hispanic churches in the network, and the ministers can share their challenges and successes in spreading the gospel.

NEWS FROM THE NETWORK:

The Iglesia de Cristo Westlawn in Huntsville, AL, is reaching out to its community by hosting the Mexican Mobile Consulate. The church ministered to 350 community members on the second Saturday in June and is planning a second event, expecting more than 1,000 community members to come through their building to serve the community for Christ. Please pray for them as they make their presence known in their community and ask God to open doors for the gospel.

The Hispanic church in Dalhart, TX, is growing despite the transient nature of the town's Hispanic community. Their growth has motivated them to help plant another Spanish worship service in a nearby town. Once a quarter, the church members go to the nearby town and hold an evening worship service for the community of Texline. They are just starting this ministry outreach, so please keep them in your prayers.

We appreciate your partnership with MESA and Herald of Truth. We are here to serve your church and reach the Hispanics in your community. Please reach out if we can be a resource for you. If you know of a church looking to reach out to Hispanics, please let us know. Pray that God continues to develop MESA.

OUR WORK IN CUBA:

After our successful trip to Cuba back in February, we were invited to come back and help with farming and agricultural training. A small group made a trip in May to help Tony and the others at the farm better understand “Farming God’s Way”, a technique using drip irrigation that allows for sustainable growth at a micro level.

Bill Orange and his wife Kaye made the trip with One Kingdom partners Robert and Cathy Ables and were also joined by Chris Youssi and Bob Turner, executive director for Hope and Equip. These partnerships allow for us to do so much more in Cuba than ever before.

We continue to work together to bring food and resources to Tony so that he might use them in an effort to share the gospel with more people every day.

MESSAGE FROM OUR VP:

Thank you all for your prayers for our mission work of sharing Jesus. We are so grateful for those of you that partner with us to share Jesus.

We are wrapping up our travel to Honduras for the summer, and our next trip to Cuba will be in 2027. The final area of our ministry of Sharing Jesus is MESA (Mission Evangelize Spanish America), and we need your partnerships to ensure that we can continue to grow with this ministry.

The ministry’s success means we need a minimum of \$250K to support the ministry by 2026-year end. Each congregation costs us—on average—\$5K. As of the writing of this article, we have raised just over \$32K for the MESA congregations so far this calendar year. This leaves a large gap of \$218K by year end.
